

Computer Use Agreement

The Library offers free use of Library computers and Internet service for all patrons. However, before using any Library computers, you must sign this Computer Use Agreement to indicate that you have read and will abide by the conditions that follow.

- You must not:
 - a. Download or store personal information on the hard drive of any Library computer.
 - b. Change any settings on any Library computer.
 - c. Alter or damage any Library computer hardware or software.
- You will be held responsible for any damage to the computer or software caused by the misuses listed above or any other misuse.
- The Library Manager is authorized to terminate your computer or Internet session, or to prohibit you from subsequent sessions, if there is cause to believe that you have misused the Library computer or software. The Library Manager will report any such action to the Library Trustees.
- If the Library Manager has terminated or prohibited your use of the Library computers, you may appeal in writing this action to the Trustees. Trustees have 30 days to review and decide on this appeal.

Parents and Guardians – Please note: Parents and/or guardians have the right and responsibility to determine and to monitor the use of Library computers by their children. The Library must have permission from a parent and/or guardian for patrons up to age 15 to access computers or the Internet. The Library will keep written permission on file and will make all reasonable efforts to comply with any parentally imposed prohibition.
